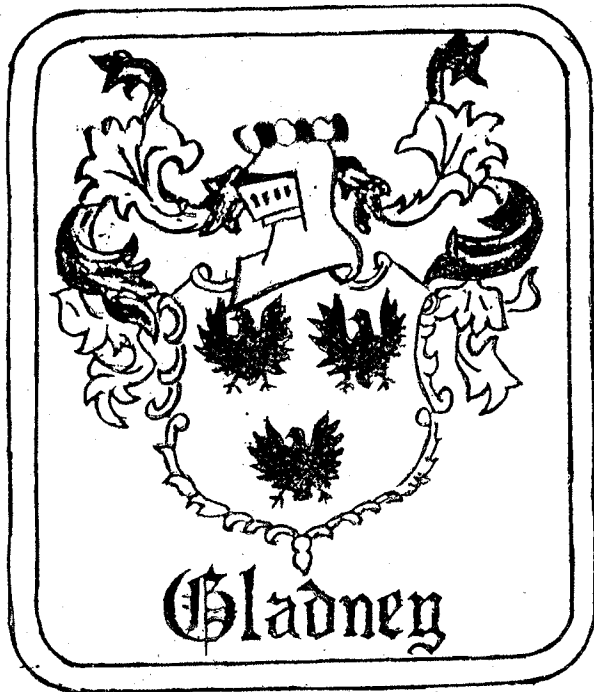

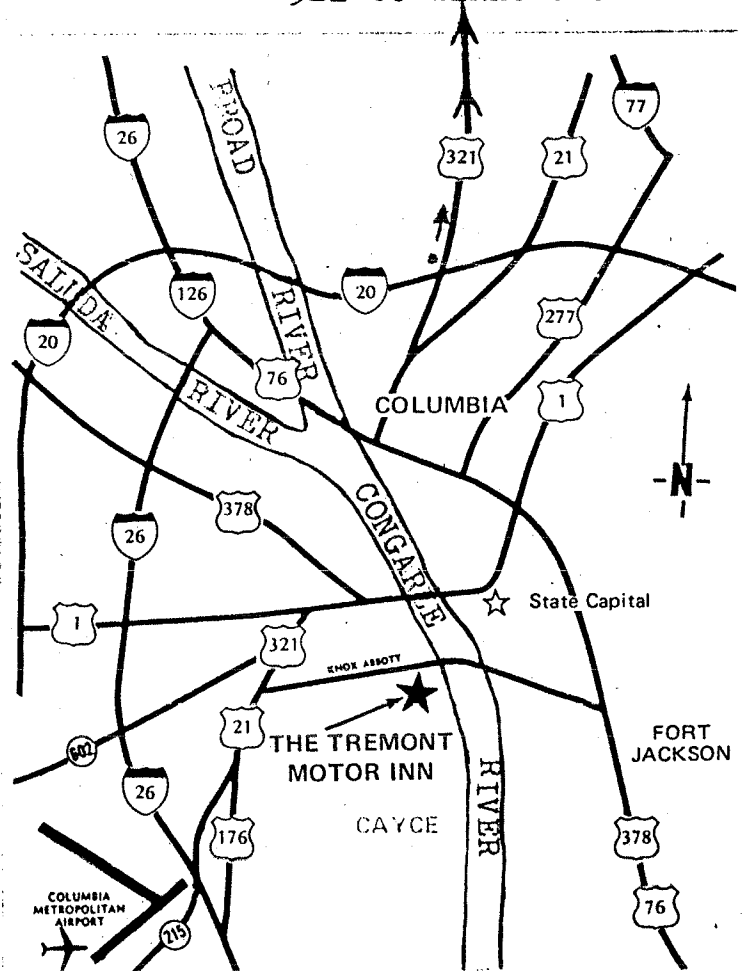
Do start planning your journey to South Carolina now to be with us for much enjoyment and social activity during this special gathering and celebration!

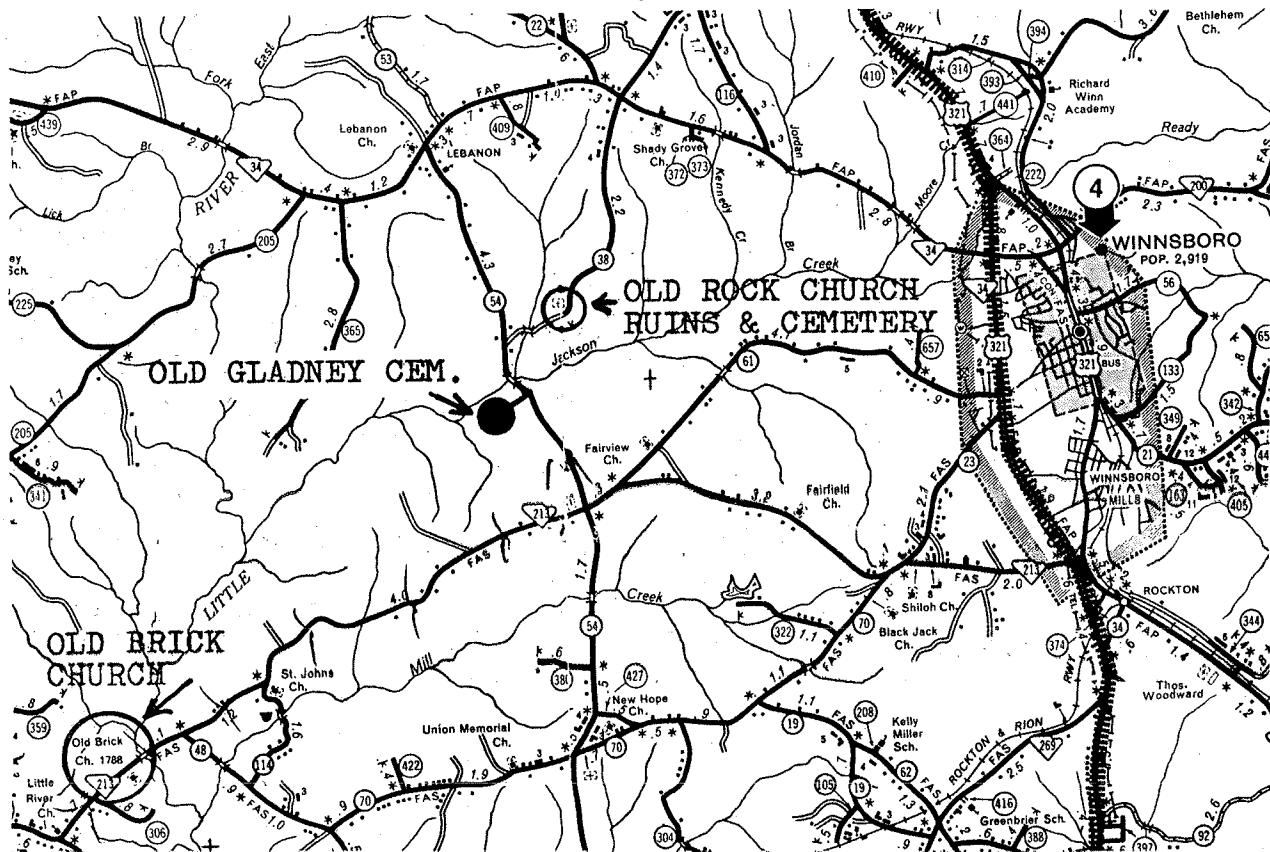
- 1:00 pm - 5:00 pm Check in, Registration, Reception in Tremont Inn meeting room.
